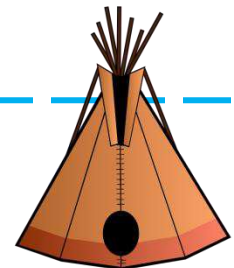
## Theme: Native American Traditions
