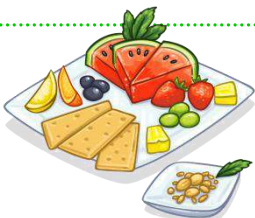
Donations

Children's Gymnastics Fall 2018:

September 10-December 20

Walking-2 Years: Monday 5:35-6:05 PM, Friday 11:20 -11:50 AM This a parent-child class in which you lead your child through a series of gymnastics stations that include balance beam, bars, rings, blocks, jumping, walking and stepping, while working on coordination, balance, strength and flexibility. **\$15 per class drop in. \$156.00 for whole session. 2 payments of \$78.00**

3 Years - Kindergarten: Monday 4:45- 5:30 PM, Friday 10:30-11:15 AM Your child will learn gymnastics gross motor skills such as rolling, jumping, cartwheels and handstands while working on balance, flexibility, strength and coordination. Learning to form a line and take turns, listening to a coach, sharing space and equipment and following directions are also important aspects of this class.

1st grade & older: Monday 3:45 – 4:40 PM This class will focus on teaching the basics and progressing skills of tumbling, jumping and body control, while developing balance, flexibility, confidence, coordination and gymnastics skills. Learning to form a line and take turns, listening to a coach, sharing space and equipment and following directions are also important aspects of this class. There will be 2 gymnastics coaches, so gymnasts will be divided by level and ability.

Tumbling (1st grade & older): Wednesday 3:45-4:40 PM This class will focus on improving and progressing gymnastics skills of tumbling, jumping and body control, while developing balance, flexibility, strength, confidence and coordination.
